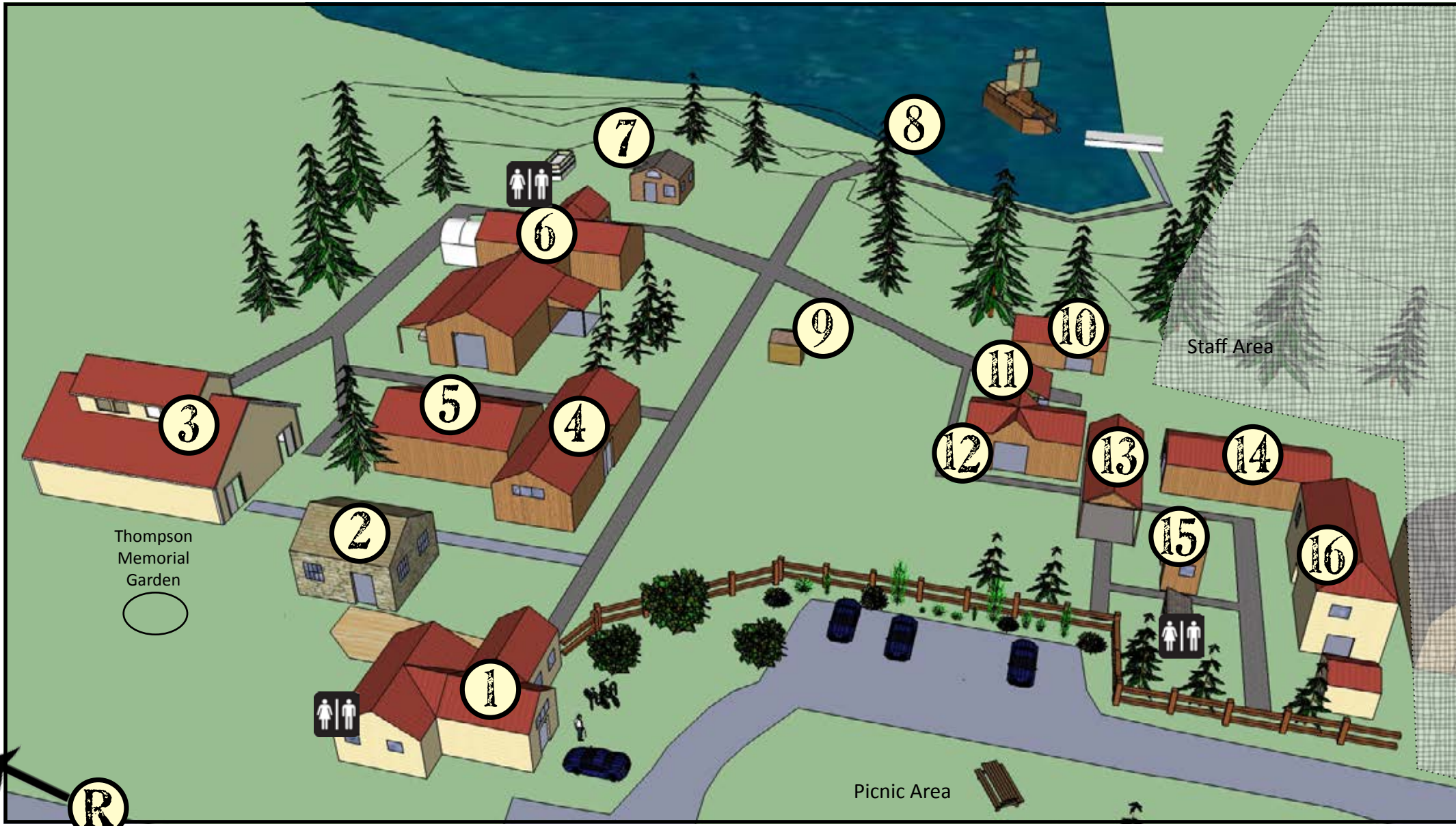


- 1 ENTRANCE**  
**Hoehl Family Education and Visitor Center**  
Welcome center, site orientation, and auditorium.  
**Museum Store**  
Gifts, toys, books, apparel, beverages and snacks.
- 2 Schoolhouse Gallery: Contact of Cultures 1609**  
**Abenaki culture through the centuries.**  
1818 Stone schoolhouse from Pantou, VT.
- 3 Hazelett Watercraft Center**  
The 1902 ice yacht *Storm King* is the centerpiece in this collection of dugout and bark canoes, kayaks, rowing skiffs, and other small watercraft.
- 4 Key to Liberty Exhibit**  
Discover the Revolutionary War in the Champlain Valley and the fate of the shipwrecks from the 1776 fleet.

- 5 Steam to Gasoline**  
Steamboats, early powerboats, engines and outboard motors. Champlain Bridge exhibit, *Champlain II* steamboat rudder.
- 6 Nautical Archaeology Center**  
Stories from some of Lake Champlain's 300 historic shipwrecks. **West Gallery** *Shipwrecks of New York*  
**Conservation Lab** Nautical archaeologists preserve objects from Lake Champlain & beyond.
- 7 The Roost & Merritime Playground**  
Adirondack-style cabin, originally part of Camp Marbury for Girls. LCMM children's activity center.
- 8 North Harbor**  
Visit our fleet of vessels. Step aboard the working replica 1776 gunboat *Philadelphia II*.
- 9 Westport Marina Winch House**  
Machinery used for hauling boats.

- 10 Blacksmith Arts Center**  
Teaching forge - ask about opportunities for one-on-one instruction, courses & workshops.
- 11 Clark Marine Diesel Engine**  
From 1947 Ferry *Valcour*, built at Shelburne Shipyard.
- 12 Maritime Trades Workshop**  
Coming Soon.
- 13 Boat Shed**  
Used for boat building workshops and special events. Headquarters for the youth boatbuilding and outdoor education program Champlain Discovery.
- 14 Boat Shop**  
Headquarters for Champlain Longboats, youth boatbuilding program.

- 15 Blacksmith Shop**  
Working 18th century-style shop where the iron fittings for the gunboat *Philadelphia II* were forged. Live blacksmithing demonstrations.
- 16 Exhibit Gallery, Owen Education Center & Offices**

- R Red Mill Restaurant at the Basin Harbor Club**  
Casual family dining for lunch and dinner in this renovated saw mill. Discount with LCMM admission.
